English Homework

From Monday 4th November, the Communications Faculty will be setting weekly English homework for every student in the school. This is in addition to any English homework a class teacher may set in order to support/enrich learning in lessons.

For Years 7-9, a writing homework will be set every Week A and a reading homework will be set every Week B. Students will have two weeks to complete each of these homework tasks. This homework will support students in developing their core literacy skills in English and across the wider curriculum.

For Years 10-11, a revision homework will be set every week for both GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature. Students will have one week to complete each of these homework tasks. This homework will support students in revising for their GCSE exams at the end of Year 11.

Full details of all homework will be published via Class Charts on a weekly basis. In the event that a student fails to submit homework without evidence of a reasonable explanation (i.e. correspondence from a parent/carer), a Conduct Point will be issued as a sanction.
