- 632 CE** Death of Muhammad

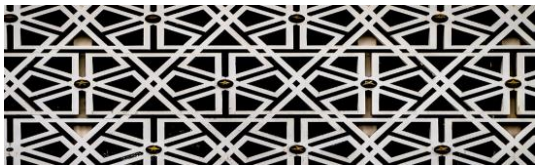

### Key Vocabulary:

- Qur'an:** the holy book revealed to Muhammad by the angel Jibril; God's final revelation to humankind
- Sunnah:** the teaching and actions of Muhammad
- Sunni:** Muslims who believe that only God or Muhammad can make laws
- Shi'a:** Muslims who believe that Muhammad began a line of people who can make laws
- Jibril:** the Arabic name for Gabriel, the angel who brought God's message to the prophets, particularly Muhammad
- Mika'il:** the Arabic name for Michael, a merciful angel who rewards good deeds
- Day of Judgement:** a time when the world will end and every soul will be judged by Allah and either rewarded or punished
- Predestination:** the idea that Allah knows or decides everything that will happen in the universe
- Akhirah:** everlasting life after death
- Resurrection:** rising from the dead or returning to life
- Heaven:** the state of eternal happiness in the presence of Allah; also called paradise
- Hell:** the state of total separation from Allah
- Prophet:** a person who gives a message from God
- Risalah:** the belief that all prophets are an important form of communication between Allah and humans
- Prophethood:** when Allah makes someone a prophet to pass on his message
- Iblis:** Satan; a spiritual being created from fire, who was thrown out of paradise for refusing to bow to Adam
- Ibrahim:** the Arabic name for the prophet Abraham
- Ka'aba:** the black, cube building in the centre of the Grand Mosque in Makkah; the holiest place in Islam
- Id-ul-Adha:** a Muslim festival that celebrates the prophet Ibrahim's sacrifice to God
- Hajj:** the annual pilgrimage to Makkah that every Muslim should try to make once in their lives
- Caliph:** a person seen as a religious successor to Muhammad, the leader of the Sunni tradition
- Imam:** either a person who leads prayer or, in the Shi'a tradition, the title given to Ali and his successors
- Imamate:** the divine appointment of the Imams
- Torah:** five books revealed by God to Moses
- Gospel:** a holy book revealed by God to Jesus
- pbuh:** Praise be upon him / praise be upon her
- Islamaphobia:** a fear or suspicion of Muslims based on no fact or understanding
- Prejudice:** judging someone or a group of people before you know or understand about them
