The popular CSI Workshop in a Box for Years 10 and 11 is back this half term on **Wednesday 2nd June**

This **virtual** workshop explores how the latest forensic science techniques are used at a Crime Scene Investigation and looks at the importance of key forensic evidence in a court of law. Everyone that takes part will be sent a kit of forensic gadgets (to keep!) prior to the session, which they will use to:

- dust for 'latent' marks including fingerprints
- analyse hair and fibre under the microscopic torch
- examine their footwear marks
- use UV lights to uncover latent marks

This session is a great introduction to the Criminal Justice System and highlights how young people can research opportunities within the Forensic Science sector, from becoming a CSI (Crime Scene Investigator), to going into Policing, becoming a Criminologist, Forensic Scientist, Ballistics Specialist, Cyber Crime Specialist and much more!
