Second opportunity June of Y11</p> <p>Students most successful attempt will be submitted for the award.</p> <p>The qualification is graded Level 1 Pass, Level 2 Pass, Level 2 Merit, Level 2 Distinction.</p> <p>Unit 1 – Safety and Security within the Construction Environment. (25% on-line exam) Knowledge covers, key Health & Safety legislation, working practices and Risk Assessment.</p> <p>Unit 2 – INTERNALLY marked, Externally moderated</p> <p>Demonstrating knowledge and understanding of how to plan for construction tasks, carry them out accurately and safely finally evaluating the quality of their work. This unit will cover Carpentry, Electrical wiring and Plumbing.</p> <p>Unit 3 – Planning Construction Projects (25% on-line exam)</p> <p>Knowledge covers the job roles involved in construction projects, planning tools and understanding the order in which processes and carried out and their time scales and the factors that effect the length of the project time.</p>	<p>Revision books/Resources</p> <p>Resource booklets to be given out in class.</p> <p>Homework to support extension of knowledge.</p> <p>Lunchtime and After School clubs when these are allowed.</p> <p>Many other resources offered to students in class, and links placed on Class Charts.</p>
