**Re: Final plans for Easter Academy**


You will find below a summary of the sessions that are taking place – your child should attend the relevant sessions that they have signed up to. Some key details about the day are as follows:

- Sessions are from 10am – 2pm. Please can students arrive promptly at the front of the school between 9.50am – 10am. The teacher will need to meet them in reception and then leave to the classroom to deliver the session. I am afraid there will be no one based on reception to allow entry to latecomers.
- There will be no catering facilities on site so students should bring refreshments for a 25 minute break in the middle of the sessions. The students will need to remain on the school site for this.
- The focus of these sessions will be revision and preparation for the final exams, or for some subjects, completion of coursework. We will have incredibly high expectations of behaviour and standards during these sessions and in the unfortunate event that a student's behaviour is causing disruption to the learning of others, they will be asked to leave. We do not anticipate this to occur, however, felt it important to make you aware. If this does occur, the teacher will phone home to inform you at the end of the session.
- Students do not need to wear school uniform for these sessions, but should bring all appropriate school equipment (pens, pencils, calculator etc...) with them.
