Re. Y11 Easter Revision Academy

We are excited to be able to offer some revision workshops during the Easter break for those students who feel that they would benefit from this additional support from their teachers. Whilst optional, we know that students who make access to this additional intervention, particularly in the final few weeks before their examinations, can make significant progress and achieve greater success in the Summer.

The revision sessions will be 2 hours long and there will be 2 sessions in a day. Students do not need to sign up to both sessions. There will be a 30 minute lunch break between the sessions where students are free to go off site to get food or to remain and eat on site in our canteen – please do note there will be no catering facilities on site on these days so students will need to bring refreshments with them. Students are not required to wear full uniform, but should bring all necessary equipment. Please note that usual expectations of behaviour apply and should any students not be meeting these expectations, they will be asked to leave.

Students should turn up promptly for each session – students must arrive no later than 5 minutes prior to the session commencing (therefore at 9.25am for the morning session and 11.55am for the afternoon session) where the staff will meet them. Given it is the Easter break, the site will be closed and therefore if students are late, there is a chance there may not be a member of staff available to meet them and they will miss the session.
