We are pleased to confirm that the Year 11 Leavers' Prom will be on Thursday 4th July 2024 at Speech House Hotel, from 6.30pm – 11.00pm.

The Leavers' Prom is always a wonderful evening and marks the end of a huge amount of hard work for students. We hope to see as many as possible there to celebrate their determination, commitment and achievements.

Students should aim to arrive at the venue between 6.30pm – 7.00pm, where they will be invited to walk up the red carpet for photographs. Cars should arrive via the field behind the hotel, allowing students the grand entrance they so rightly deserve. There will be a buffet meal, served at 7.30pm, followed by presentations and a disco. Students should be collected from the venue no later than 11.00pm.

The cost of a ticket is £37.50, which includes a buffet and dessert. Please use Parentpay to inform us of any dietary requirements. School staff will attend Prom and, while parents and guardians are welcome to join us on the field outside Speech House to watch the cars arrive, Speech house do not allow other adults into the venue at all during the evening.

To purchase a ticket and confirm attendance for your son / daughter, please log onto Parentpay, alternatively you can pay using Pay Point by Friday 24th May 2024 at the latest. Any student who does not purchase a ticket will not be allowed into the venue or the field for photographs.

Please note that poor behaviour in school or persistent unauthorised absence prior to the Prom may mean that certain students are unable to attend. In these situations, it may not be possible to refund the purchase price of the ticket. The decision over who is allowed to attend Prom is at the discretion of SLT and you will be informed of any decisions prior to the day of the event.
