GCSE Geography Fieldwork

I am writing to you to confirm the arrangements for the fieldwork proposed for the GCSE Geography course that your daughter/son has chosen to take this year. **Fieldwork is a vital component of the Geography course.** It is essential that the fieldwork is carried out as it will be assessed in Paper 2 of the Geography exams. As part of the course pupils are required to complete a human and a physical fieldwork study. They will not be required to wear uniform on these days but need to dress appropriately for the weather and activities.

The fieldwork planned is as follows:-

Wednesday 23rd September (10B and 10D) and Thursday 24th September (10A and 10C): We will be carrying out a river study at Wenchford, Blakeney Straights. Pupils will be out of school for 3 hours this day and will be told of their time slot in advance. Pupils will need to wear clothes suitable for wading in rivers and bring shoes / wellies for this purpose.

Please note that poor behaviour in lessons / around school may mean that students will not be allowed to attend the fieldwork days.

Consent and medical information must be filled in on Parentpay or a paper copy collected from reception if necessary.
